### 2012 – A Historical Milestone in Belgian Swimming History

However, I must also extend my gratitude to Mr. Ludo VAN CAMPENHOUT, the vice-mayor of the city of Antwerp, to the marketing agency GOLAZO and to Mr. Jan VAN ESBROECK, director of the Antwerp Sportpaleis, for their vital support to the overall success of this EC2012-event that will be held in a unique and amazing indoor venue.

I hereby also would like to express my gratitude to LEN for their confidence to allocate these championships to our country.

Finally, on behalf of the Royal Belgian Swimming Federation, I bid you a double warm welcome to Belgium and to the city of Antwerp, in May and in July 2012. I wish all of you the best luck, excitement and enjoyment and I am sincerely proud and honored to see you all in “Antwerp 2012”.

## History of the Royal Belgian Swimming Federation

The Royal Belgian Swimming Federation was founded in 1902 by 7 swimming associations in order to introduce and to govern organised swimming in Belgium. The 1st official name was “Fédération Belge des Sociétés de Natation” but later this was changed into “Fédération Belge de Natation”. The oldest swimming club in Belgium is Cercle de Natation Bruxelles (CNBA), established in June 1890. The second club that was founded in our country on 24<sup>th</sup> of July 1895 was the Antwerpse Zwemclub (AZC). This Antwerp Swimming Club, which we now know under the name “Antwerpse Zwemclub Scaldis (AZSC)” is the basis of the local organising committee for all European Championships in Antwerp, in co-operation with the Flemish Swimming Federation and the Royal Belgian Swimming Federation. In 1920, Antwerp was also host of the Games of the VIIth Olympiad and as a matter of fact, it was AZC that was part of the organisation of the swimming competition during these Olympics. In 1903 Fernand Feyaerts was the 1<sup>st</sup> official Belgian Champion swimming (100m freestyle).



On July 19<sup>th</sup> 1908 in Manchester, 10 European countries, including Belgium, founded the Fédération Internationale de Natation – International Swimming Federation (FINA). The Ligue Européenne de Natation – European Swimming Federation (LEN) was founded in Budapest in 1926, once again Belgium was one of the co-founders. In the first decades of LEN and FINA, René De Raeve (General Secretary of the Royal Belgian Swimming Federation from 1926 to 1968) took an important leading role in these international swimming bodies. He was President of FINA 1948-1952 and President of LEN 1950-1954.

In 1977 two regional swimming leagues (Vlaamse Zwemliga and Ligue Francophone Belge de Natation) were created. The Royal Belgian Swimming Federation remained of course the only national governing body for all aquatic sports.

When entering the 21<sup>st</sup> century Belgium hosted some important European events with the support of the same Antwerp Swimming Club and the local organizing committee President, Mr. Georges STRAETEMANS:

**1998** – 2<sup>nd</sup> Organisation of European Junior Swimming Championships in Antwerp (1<sup>st</sup> edition in 1991).

**2001** – 1<sup>st</sup> Organisation of European Short Course Swimming Championships in Antwerp

**2002** – Celebration of 100th anniversary of the Royal Belgian Swimming Federation in Brussels

**2007** – 1<sup>st</sup> Organisation of Annual European LEN Congress in Brussels

**2007** – 3<sup>rd</sup> Organisation of European Junior Swimming Championships in Antwerp

And last but not least, in the year **2012**, we are celebrating the 110<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Royal Belgian Swimming Federation, but more important: Belgium will be “back in swimming business” since the beautiful and “brilliant” city of Antwerp is about to become, once more, the centre of European Aquatics. Not only will Belgium/Antwerp be the first national federation to host the European Junior Swimming Championships for the 4<sup>th</sup> time, but most of all - for the first time ever - the European Championships Swimming and Synchronized Swimming will take place in Belgium and the city of Antwerp, European Capital of Sports 2013.

## LEN EVENT RULES (UPDATE 14 MAY 2011)

### EUROPEAN SWIMMING JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

In addition to the LEN General Event Rules the following **REGULATIONS** shall apply:

#### J-SW 1 ORGANISATION

J-SW 1.1 The Championships shall be held every year.

J-SW 1.2 The organising Federation and the place where the Championships will be held shall be decided by the LEN Bureau and circulated by the LEN Office.

J-SW 1.3 Four (4) Delegates, one (1) to be appointed by the Bureau and three (3) by the LEN Technical Swimming Committee (LEN TSC), will be responsible for and supervise the organisation and the correct conduct of the competitions according to LEN Rules and Regulations. One of the TSC Delegates shall act as Control Room Supervisor in the Timing Room.

The Delegates will decide on all matters arising on site at the competitions which require an immediate decision.

#### J-SW 2 EVENTS & PARTICIPATION

J-SW 2.1 Age Groups are:

- a) Men: 17 and 18 years;
- b) Women: 15 and 16 years.

J-SW 2.2 Events are (men and women):

- a) Freestyle 50 m, 100 m, 200 m, 400 m, 800 m, 1500 m;
- b) Breaststroke 50 m, 100 m, 200 m;
- c) Backstroke 50 m, 100 m, 200 m;
- d) Butterfly 50 m, 100 m, 200 m;
- e) Individual Medley 200 m, 400 m;
- f) Freestyle Relays 4 x 100 m, 4 x 200 m;
- g) Medley Relay 4 x 100 m.

J-SW 2.3 In individual events a maximum of four (4) entries per Federation and per event may be submitted.

Notwithstanding the times or places achieved in the heats, only the two (2) fastest swimmers of the respective Federation may:

- a) proceed to the semi-finals and/or finals;
- b) take part in a swim off;
- c) be nominated as a reserve.

In any event where heats are not held a maximum of two (2) swimmers per Federation may take part in semi-finals, finals or timed finals.

J-SW 2.4 In relay events entries for one (1) team per Federation and per event may be submitted.

All swimmers entered for the Championships may swim in relays. The composition of a relay team may be changed between heats and finals of an event.

J-SW 2.5 The order of the events will be circulated by the LEN Office.

### **J-SW 3 FORMAT**

#### **J-SW 3.1 Standards and Lane Placing**

J-SW 3.1.1 Entries will be accepted regardless of standards, but they shall include entry times.

J-SW 3.1.2 The entry time shall be taken from the LEN Ranking list.

Only entry times achieved in a 50m pool shall be accepted. Entry times shall not be older than twelve (12) months prior to the first day of the swimming competition.

J-SW 3.1.3 Lane placing will be:

- a) for individual swimming according to FINA Rules, based on the entry times;
- b) for relay heats and direct finals by draw.

J-SW 3.1.4 Heats, Semi-Finals and Finals may be swum using 10 lanes.

#### **J-SW 3.2 Qualification System**

J-SW 3.2.1 In the 50m, 100m and 200m events there will be heats, semi-finals and finals.

J-SW 3.2.2 In the 400m and relay events there will be heats and finals.

J-SW 3.2.3 In 800m and 1500m events there will be timed finals.

J-SW 3.2.4 Where semi-finals are held the qualifiers for the final will be the 1st and 2nd in each semi-final together with the four (4) fastest from the remaining swimmers in the semi-finals.

In events without semi-finals, qualification for the final shall be based on times established in the heats in accordance with FINA Rules.

J-SW 3.2.5 An individual swimmer or a relay team qualified but not wishing to take part in a semi-final or final shall withdraw within thirty (30) minutes from the end of the heats or semi-finals concerned; otherwise a fine according to Rule E 16.6 will be imposed.

J-SW 3.2.6 Reserves for semi-finals and finals will be the next ranked swimmers in the heats and semi-finals respectively. Team managers are responsible to ensure that reserves are present. A Federation failing to do so shall be fined according to E 16.6.

#### **J-SW 3.3 Relays**

The composition of relay teams shall be declared in order of swimming no later than one hour before the commencement of the session in which the race will take place. In a case of emergency the referee on request in writing may accept changes up to the time of the start.

## J-SW 4 ENTRIES

J-SW 4.1 Preliminary Entries shall be submitted to the organising Federation, with copy to the LEN Office, no later than the date circulated by the LEN Office.

J-SW 4.2 A Federation having made a Preliminary Entry may withdraw up to the date circulated by the LEN Office.

J-SW 4.3 Named entries shall be submitted to the organising Federation, with copy to the LEN Office, no later than ten (10) days before the first day of the competition, if not announced otherwise.

J-SW 4.4 Competitors who cannot prove identity, age and citizenship shall not be permitted to take part in the competitions.

## J-SW 5 ACCREDITATION

J-SW 5.1 Federations entering the Championships will receive accreditation free of charge for:

- a) the President of the Federation;
- b) the Head of the Delegation;
- c) the entered competitors;
- d) one medical person;
- e) a second medical person if more than twenty competitors have been entered;
- f) one physiotherapist for up to 10 athletes entered, two for 10 to 20 athletes entered, three for 20 to 30 athletes entered, etc.
- g) team staff members:
  - 6 for up to 15 competitors;
  - 7 for up to 20 competitors;
  - 8 for more than 20 competitors.

The number of team staff members may not exceed the number of competitors.

J-SW 5.2 Team staff members include everybody servicing the team: Team Leaders, Chaperones, Coaches, Physiotherapists, Interpreters, etc. (not officials such as judges, referees, etc.).

## J-SW 6 OFFICIALS

J-SW 6.1 In addition to the Technical Delegates, the LEN TSC will appoint two(2) referees and one (1) starter.

J-SW 6.2 Federations may nominate one or two officials qualified from one of the current FINA lists. Nominations shall be submitted to the LEN Office no later than the date circulated by the LEN Office. Officials approved by the LEN TSC are on the costs of the nominating Federation.

J-SW 6.3 The organising Federation shall supply all the other officials.

J-SW 6.4 The LEN Technical Delegate and the Referee(s) will nominate the officials in charge for each competition day.

### VENUE

The swimming competition will take place in the Olympic swimming pool Wezenberg.

Swimming facilities will include an 8-lane pool with a depth of 3 meter to 3.80 meter and a separate warming-up pool measuring 21 meter by 20 meter.

This same Olympic Pool Wezenberg was also the competition venue for to the European Junior Swimming Championships of 1991, 1998 and 2007.

## Swimming Pool 'Wezenberg' Antwerp

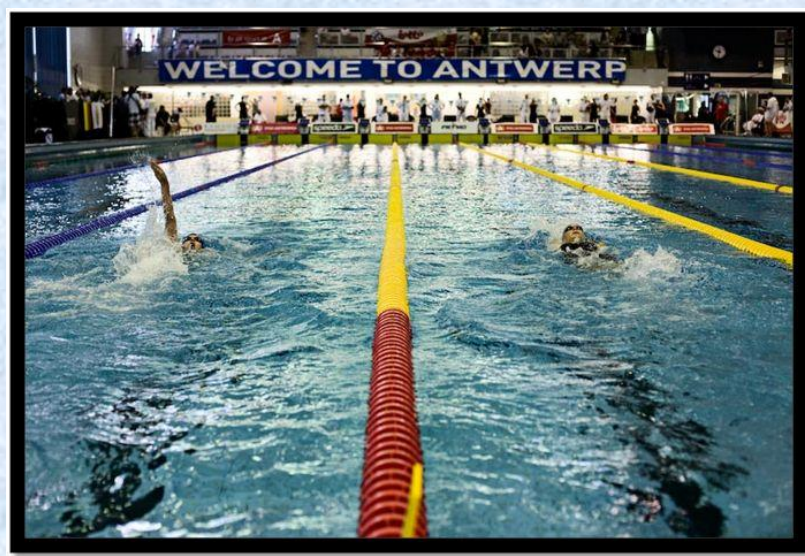
The Olympic Swimming pool Wezenberg, for the 4th time host of the European Junior Championships (from 4 until 8 July 2012), has been the stage of many important swim meets since its opening in 1973.

Apart from the annual regional championships and international swim meets (such as the Antwerp International Youth Swimming Cup and the Flanders Swimming Cup), the swimming pool has regularly been the stage of Belgian and Flemish championships. In 2001, the European Short Course Championships were even held in this magnificent swimming complex. Besides that, the swimming pool was also the stage of the European Junior Championships in 1991, 1998 and 2007.

The complex covers an area of 7,500 m<sup>2</sup> and the stands can seat up to approximately 800 spectators. The swimming pool was renovated in 2001-2002.

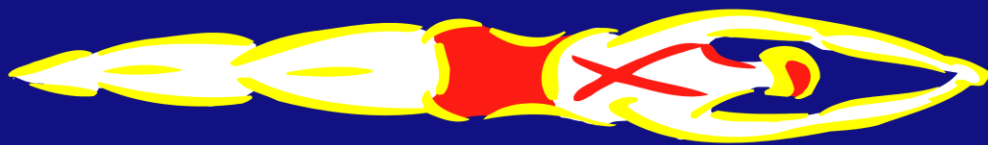
