- Small pool 16m length, 0,8m depth, for warm ups

System of the competition: Groups will be formed according to the times applied. The fastest group starts the last.

- 9 AM. Officials' meeting and warm up until 9:45 AM.
 - 9:45 AM. Opening
 - 10 AM. The beginning of the competition
 - 4 PM. Warm up until 4:45 PM.
 - 5 PM. The beginning of the second part of the competition
- Medal events will be held during the competition according to the schedule.

The rules:

- All the swimmers, registered with their national federations, have right to take part in the competition
- Each swimmer, in every category, has right to compete in 3 (three) disciplines by part
- Three swimmers to reach the finish line in each discipline will be awarded with a medal.
- The following three races will be taken into consideration and scored for the most successful competitor: 200m mixed, 800m freestyle and one 50m race of choice.
- The swimmer who does not turn up at the start will not be taken into consideration for the most successful competitor.
- The most successful competitors (male and female), Absolutely, will be awarded with a cup and a money prize.
- The competitor who finishes the best race of the whole competition according to FINA points, will win Martin Burnach trophy.
- The club with the best score wins **Polet Cup 2014**.
- C Category takes part in individual and team scoring for the **Sombor-Baja fraternity towns cup** (FINA points). The competition in Baja will be held on 12th April 2014.
